Site Walk:

Stuart discussed site plan drawing describing wetlands, setbacks and deed restrictions to protect the site and lake for the public. He then placed lot corner markers along Otisfield Cove Road to assist in visualizing boundaries. Joe Zilensky raised a concern regarding the impact on the lake of any pollution with the slow turnover of lake's waters. Stuart indicated the phosphorus control plan and included buffers should adequately address the issue.

Access to the common area (for 4 lots) raised concern as no off road parking is planned. Street parking would impede access for emergency vehicles. A 'no parking at beach' restriction was asked to be added to the deeds.

Having viewed the lots off Otisfield Cove Road, it was deemed unnecessary to view from Cobb Hill Rd.
