




Otisfield Mask Policy

"The Board of Selectmen discussed and unanimously agreed that masks are mandatory at any and all Otisfield board and committee meetings, hearings and other town sanctioned meetings. This also includes any transactions at the town office where only one person at a time will be assisted.

Should someone not wish to attend or participate in any town event, due to masks that are required, the participating committee or board and the Select Board fully support his/her personal choices. The Selectmen would advise participating members and attendees to follow their own individual choices and not engage in any verbal debates centered around other people's choices. We ask that participants remain respectful and noncombative surrounding this issue.

Unless the Maine CDC and Governor change or modify the current mask order that has enforcement consequences, the town will not do otherwise.
