**5.** A Climate To Thrive (ACTT) partnership – signed letter of support to partner with Mount Desert Island and CEBE's submission to the SOLVE IT Prize through the DOE. If they receive the money, they will hold a series of conferences in partnership with West Paris, Norway and Otisfield to educate us on the need for clean energy literacy and community driven solutions to the environmental and energy issues our towns are facing.

**6. Federal Priorities Grant:** we received \$100,000. Solar panels will be installed on our Town Office roof – CEBE will arrange to have this done. Our committee will be responsible for holding a community energy fair in the summer of 2025.
